VISION STATEMENT

As parents, relatives, alumni, and friends of students attending the Bishop O'Reilly educational system,

we are committed to establishing a distinctly Catholic, academically excellent, fiscally sound entity.

Through growing enrollment, we will transform our Catholic education system into a viable, perpetual presence. Within this community we will teach faith and trust in God and respect for life. We will instill the desire to learn. We will encourage strength through prayer. We will empower our children to lead through "courage, truth and justice . . ."

- We will run a consolidated Catholic High School System with the merger of Bishop O'Reilly and Seton Catholic High Schools. This will include junior high grades 7th and 8th presently housed in Bishop O'Reilly.
- We will reduce the existing parish subsidies 25% over 5 years. We will operate on a fiscally sound, go forward basis.¹
- In order to provide sufficient operating revenues, we will reintroduce a negotiated tuition program which was very successful in previous years.

 This will make a Catholic education affordable for all families in our large demographic area.
- We will develop a long range plan for capital improvements and maintenance of our facilities. Our committee on physical plants has determined that no major improvements are necessary. II

- We will maintain the academically excellent curriculum and standards which are ranked among the highest in the area. We will also expand our current Individual Instruction Program which is staffed by caring, dedicated educators and utilizes our established unique and comfortable atmosphere.
- *We request reintroduction of a Catholic religious presence in the school. *IV
- We will reorganize the governance of the school to provide a strong foundation for the future operation of this Catholic School System.
- We will expand and enhance extra curricular programs and activities throughout the school including Arts and Athletics.

- We will utilize vast amounts of expertise and talent available from parents, alumni, and friends who comprise the Community of Bishop O'Reilly. Committees are already in place and are tapping into these resources.
- ❖ We are reorganizing parent and alumni associations to provide additional support for finances, academics, operations, and development.
- Finally, we will make the Bishop O'Reilly Education System a success story for the Diocese of Scranton, which will be used as a model for Catholic school systems throughout America.
